WAKULLA SPRINGS, FLORIDA

DECEMBER 3 - 5, 2010

Our foray will return to Wakulla Springs State Park & Lodge, Wakulla Springs, FL, located 15 miles south of Tallahassee. www.floridastateparks.org

The historic Lodge, built in 1937, and surrounding natural resources, is designated as a National Natural Landmark, and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The Lodge stands now as it did in the 1930's, and to stay here is a unique experience. The park features one of the world's largest and deepest fresh water springs, surrounded by nearly 3000 acres of pristine forest. Saturday forays are being planned into the surrounding areas.

Dr. Tom Volk, Professor of Biology at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, will be our guest mycologist. Dr. Bart Buyck of the National Museum of Natural History in Paris, France, will be visiting the US for a few weeks, and will give a talk.

Cost is \$294-single, and \$354-double. Registration includes your room and two meals. There is a Lodge Dining Room for other meals.
