

-Page 1, Standard Rigging:

- A. Standard Rigging, Bow View Showing Light Pole w/Light for Nighttime Use.
- **B.** Standard Rigging, Bow View.
- C. Standard Rigging, Side View.
- D. Standard Rigging, Stern View.

-Page 2, Outback for Two and Surf Launch Rigging:

- A. Who said you have to get a tandem kayak to haul two people? Picture Shows Second Seat Installed That Will Accommodate a Child. See Title Picture on Cover Page Showing 3 Year-Old in Seat. Have Also Comfortably Seated My 8 Year-Old.
- **B.** Surf Launch Rigging, Bow View.
- C. Outback for Two, Stern View.
- **D.** Connection Points for Second Seat (*Standard Hobie Seat*) in Outback for Two.
- E. Surf Launch Rigging, Side View. Also Shows Orange Safety Flag.

-Page 3, Light the Night:

- A. Standard Rigging, Showing 1/2" PVC Light Pole w/Hydrostar Light for Nighttime Use. The Hydrostar is a Multifunction LED Light w/Three Brightness Settings, a Strobe, and a Red/Green Marker Light. Comes with Magnetic Base, Suction Cup Mount, and Bungee Leash as Mounting Options.
- **B.** Close-Up of Hydrostar Light Attached to 1/2" PVC Via 1-1/2" x 1/2" Bushing and Stainless Steel Screw for Bungee Leash.
- C. End of PVC Bushing Showing Large Metal Washer for Hydrostar's Magnetic Base to Connect to. *Also Shows Plastic Hook for River Creek LED Lantern*.
- **D.** Light Pole Showing Hydrostar and River Creek LED Lantern Mounted/Hung.
- E. River Creek LED Lantern Showing 7" from Base to Top of Wire Hanger. A LOT of Light in a Little Package!
- F. Close-Up of Light Pole, Hydrostar, and River Creek LED Lantern.

-Page 4, Seat and Front Hatch:

- A. Standard Hobie Seat with Beloved Crack of Dawn, Self-Inflatable Seat Cushion. *Best Insurance Against "Numb-Butt"*!!!
- B. Standard Hobie Seatback w/Two Water Bottles. Bag Contents Spare Bungee Cords, Multipurpose Tool, SPF 30 Lip Balm, Sunscreen, Bug Spray, Glasses Case, Wet-Ones TM, Zip-LocTM Bag (Contents: Extra Zip LocTM Bags, Plastic Trash Bags, Toilet Paper, WD-40 Lubricant), 25' Dog Leash/Bow Line, and Extra Zip Ties.
- C. Front Hatch "Prop-Stick", 14-1/2" Dowel w/Paracord Loop Drilled Into End.
- **D.** Safety and Comfort Dry Bag Attached to Paracord Loop Around Sail Mast Via Carabiner.
- E. Safety and Comfort Dry Bag Contents Hydrostar Light, Duck (Not Duct!) Tape, Vaseline, First Aid Kit, Wet-OnesTM. Yes, the sea is a lonely place, but the Vaseline is actually for use with my fishfinder transducer temporary installation!!!

-Page 5, Anchor and Trolley:

- A. Anchor, Plastic-Coated Chain, Nylon Cord, Buoy, and Clip.
- **B.** Anchor Trolley from Middle of Port Side to Stern.
- C. Anchor Deployed in Trolley with Cord Locked into Cleat.
- **D.** Close-Up of Anchor Trolley Clip.

-Page 6, Stakeout/Push Pole w/Florida Sportsman Lawstick Sticker/Ruler:

- A. Stakeout/Push Pole in 5' 5" Standard Configuration. Can Be Extended with Additional 5' Extension.
- **B.** Florida Sportsman Magazine's Lawstick Sticker. Allows for Measurements up to 36" with Special Notations and Markings of Popular Saltwater Fish Minimum and Maximum Lengths according to State of Florida Laws.
- C. Ruler Starts at Base of PVC "T" Section on Pole.
- **D.** Close-Up of PVC "T" Section on Pole.
- E. Close-Up of Extension Pole w/ Coupling and PVC "4-Way" at Bottom End of Pole.
- F. Stakeout/Push Pole w/Florida Sportsman Lawstick Sticker/Ruler Stowed in Starboard Side Paddle Holder. Allows for fast and easy (approximate) measurement of fish without having to fully remove fish from water.

-Page 7, Mirage Drive and Internal Gear Trolley:

- A. Hole Drilled Through Frame of Mirage Drive for Stainless Steel Shackle w/Cable Leash and Brass Clip.
- **B.** Mirage Drive Leashed to Deck Loop Just Behind Front Hatch.
- C. Mirage Drive Pedal Weighted with 1-1/2 Oz. Egg Sinker. Egg Sinker Attached w/Standard Epoxy.
- D. Paracord Internal Gear Trolley Forward Loop Shown Going Around Sail Mast Recptacle. *Rear Loop Goes Around Scupper Hole Support Behind Seat in Tankwell Area.*
- E. View of Hull Through Hatch In Front of Seat Showing Dry Bag Connected to Internal Gear Trolley. *Move Paracord to Slide Attached Gear Forward or Backward in Hull.*

-Page 8, Eagle FishEasy 240 Fishfinder Installation:

- A. Dry Pak (*Waterproof Bag*) Containing 8-Cell AA Battery Pack, Fuse, and Extra Fuses.
- **B.** Screw Protectors Over the Inputs (1/2") and Wire Plug (3/8").
- C. Transducer Foam Puck Just Behind Sail Mast Receptacle In Hull Behind Front Hatch.
- **D.** Dry Pak with Batteries Attached to Hull on Port Side. Attached Via Caribiner to Paracord Loop Ran Through RAM Ball Mount Wellnut (See E.). Also Shows White, Plastic Hook Mounted with Silicone Useful for Suspending Dry Bags, Lunch Bag, Etc.
- E. RAM Ball Mount, Loop of Paracord Running Through RAM Ball Mount Wellnut, and Wire Plug Running Through Rubber Stopper.
- F. Installed and Connected Eagle FishEasy 240 Fishfinder.

-Page 9, Tankwell and Fishing Equipment:

- A. Flush-Fitting Scupper Plug (Non-OEM) in Tankwell.
- **B.** Close-Up of Flush-Fitting Scupper Plug.
- C. Side View of Crate Mate. *File Crate Tackle Bag w/Interior Velcro Straps, Six External D-Rings for Accessories and Tie-Downs, and Four Rod Holders.*
- **D.** Berkley Lip Gripper w/Buoy, Mounted.
- **E.** Stern View of Tankwell w/Tacklebox and Frabill Min-O₂-LifeTM Bait Station.
- F. Pliers and Scissors, Mounted.

-Page 10, Homemade Kayak and Accessory Rack:

NOTE: Kayaks Typically Stored in OPTIMAL Hull Up Fashion!

- A. Stern View of Kayak and Accessory Rack Loaded.
- **B.** Port View of Kayak and Accessory Rack Loaded.
- C. Bow View of Empty Kayak and Accessory Rack.
- D. Starboard View of Kayak and Accessory Rack Loaded.

-Page 11, Extend-A-Truck II (MSRP = ~\$130):

- A. 2007 Ford Explorer SportTrac w/Extend-A-Truck II in "down", bedextension configuration with a 2006 Hobie Outback loaded.
- **B.** Unloaded Extend-A-Truck II in "down", bed-extension configuration.
- C. Unloaded Extend-A-Truck II in "up", rooftop-hauling configuration.
